Virginia readers: Please note that this should replace the Arizona graduation requirements (page 8) in the preview edition of *High School 101: Blueprint for Success* (60-page seminar notes CD or booklet).

#### For a Standard Diploma:

English - 4 credits

Mathematics - 3 credits (Algebra I and above)

Lab science -3

History/Social Science -3

Health and PE - 2

Fine arts or Practical Arts - 1

Electives - 6

(For a total of 22 credits)

Note: History should include Va & US History, Va & US Government, and one world history/geography course in the public schools. The school board may approve additional courses to satisfy these requirements.

Also note: In mathematics, Algebra 1 counts as 1 credit, or Algebra I Part I (or Part A) counts as 1 credit, and Algebra I Part 2 or B counts as another credit (although both portions A/B must be completed for either to count). So in a public school setting, if your child needs to slow down to complete algebra, he gets 2 credits for it. If you choose to do it that way, that should be reflected on the transcript.

#### For an Advanced Studies Diploma:

English - 4

Mathematics - 4 (3 must be from Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, or another course above Algebra 2)

Lab science - 4

History/Social Science - 4 (see notes on standard - must include 2 world history or geography courses)

Foreign language - 3 (3 of one language or 2 each of two languages)

Health and PE - 2

Fine arts or Practical arts - 1

Electives - 2
